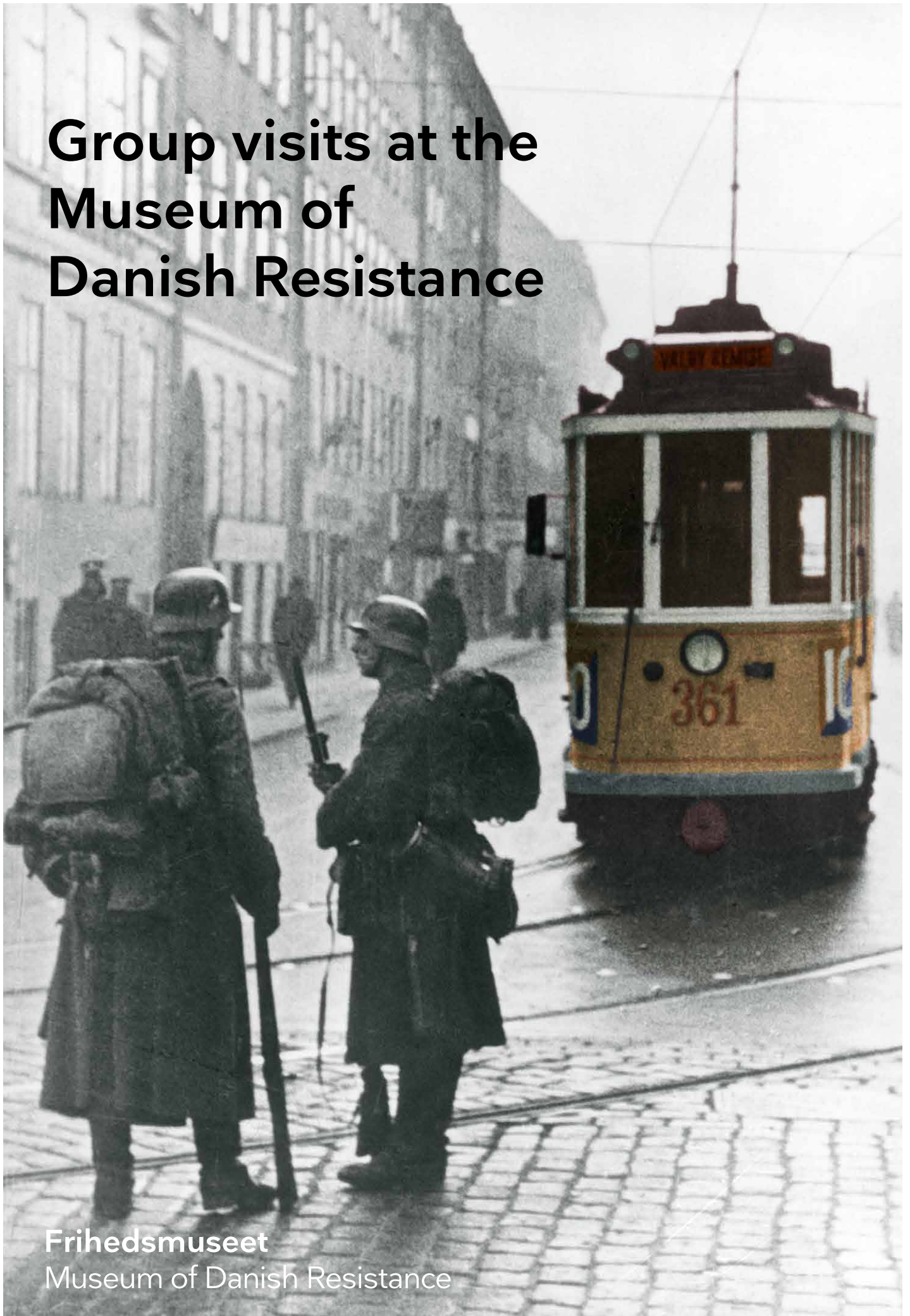


Group visits at the Museum of Danish Resistance

Authorized tour guides are welcome to guide groups at the Museum of Danish Resistance.

Groups need to reserve time to be sure to access the museum at a specific time.

The museum reserves the right to reject groups without reservation.

At the moment, it is possible to visit the museum with groups at 10.15, at 11.00, at 13.15 and at 14.00.

It is also possible to visit the museum with groups outside normal opening hours for a fee.

NOTE: A large part of the exhibition is built for the use of audio guide it is unfortunately not possible to offer the groups headsets. Please note that the group will therefore not experience this part of the exhibition at their visit.



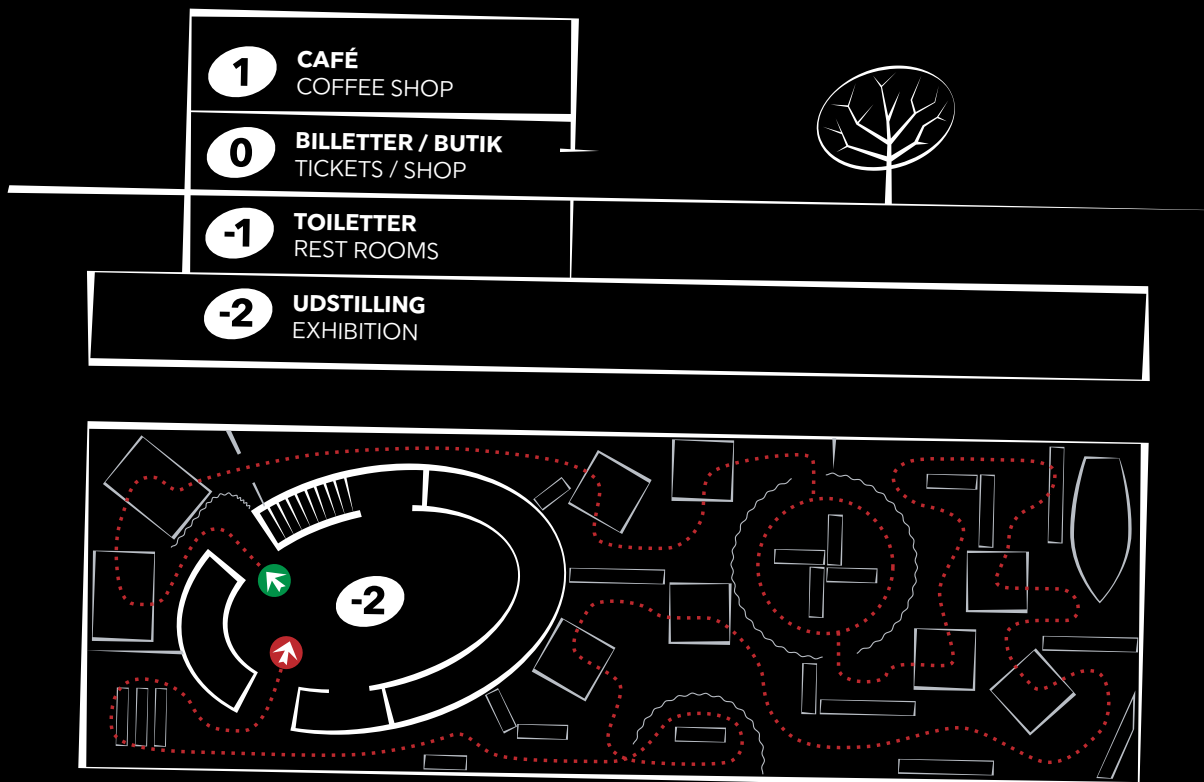
BEFORE THE VISIT

- Bus parking: Parking and boarding can be done at the drop-off zone in front of the museum's main entrance: Esplanaden 13.
- The guide must pay special attention to the bike path when guests step out of the bus.
- For official bus parking we refer to the Churchill Park.
- Before entering, the guide must inform the group about rules and practical matters, including that it is possible to pay with € and \$ in the museum shop. But only banknotes, NOT coins and change is given back in Danish currency.
- There are limited wardrobe facilities and only space for small bags. For storage of large bags and suitcases, we refer to storage at LuggageHero in Bredgade.
- It is not allowed for groups to stay long on floor -1 and in the rotunda on floor -2 (see map)
- Groups have access to the museum via the Esplanaden 13.

DURING THE VISIT

Before starting the tour, the guide must inform the group about the visiting rules:

- Objects at the museum must not be touched. The guide should keep the visitors in the group together.
- A guided tour must last a maximum of 50 minutes unless otherwise agreed in advance.
- Speak softly and show consideration for other guests and groups.
- Do not go in front of another guided tour.
- The tour takes place with entrance from the door with the green light. (See map)
- Food and drink may not be brought to the exhibitions. Food and drinks can be bought in the cafe on the 1st floor.
- Photographing without the use of a flash is allowed with a mobile phone and handheld camera
- Intoxicated behavior is not accepted.
- Recommendation from our staff must be complied with



AFTER THE VISIT
